A broad, seductive compote of concentrated black cherries, cranberries displaying layered, textured truffle savouriness and earthy forest floor interwoven with concentrated black cherry compote harmoniously supported by mineral tannin.

40 | Corryton Burge | Chardonnay | South Australia | £34

A lively, rich, round and creamy South Australian Chardonnay. Pale to yellow straw, Aromatic white nectarine, with hints of peach and pear. Palate provides generous fresh stone fruit and honeydew melon with a hint of creamy shortbread richness all brought together with moderate acidity to provide balance.

41 | Philip Shaw, The Dreamer | Viognier | New South Wales | £49.50

The Dreamer is light straw yellow in colour with hues of green. Fresh apricots and violets on the nose with lifts of lemon. The palate is bright and fresh with vivid acid and juicy fruit. The balance of fruit and acid give the wine depth and vibrancy.

82 | Corryton Burge | Shiraz | South Australia | £34

Deep ruby red with purple hues, strawberry, raspberry and vanilla aromas. Rich fruit forward characters of raspberry and plums tantalise the palate. A soft toasty oak influence enhances the vanilla and spice. Subtle tannins leave the palate quite moreish and a delight to keep coming back to.

83 | Vasse Felix Filius | Cabernet Sauvignon | Margaret River | £55

Juicy, intense, and luscious on entry with fast building super fine and powdery tannin. It is soft yet solid, elegantly taut, and super-luscious with concentrated fresh raspberry, vanilla pod and savoury nutmeg on the finish.

43 | Wildsong Organic | Pinot Gris | Hawkes Bay | £44

Pear, lychee and quince, muddled with loquat, almond and nectarine. An attractive textured palate with a balanced, dry finish that suits drinking chilled on its own or served alongside pretty much anything. 🌱

84 | Trinity Hill | Syrah | Hawkes Bay | £52

Combines spice and pepper with ripe blackberry fruit for a rich and soft palate offering a long and complex finish.

85 | Tohu | Pinot Noir | Marlborough | £55


A bright ruby hue in the glass, this Awatere Valley Pinot Noir displays aromatic layers of red fruit and spicy florals with hints of crushed herbs. The palate is smooth with flavours of bright cherry, red berries and finely integrated French oak. Mid-weight on the palate, this wine is balanced with refined silky tannins that lead to a long and elegant finish. 🌱

101 | Chambers, Rosewood Vineyard | Muscat | Rutherglen Victoria, Australia | Bottle 37.5cl £46 | 125ml £16.90

The Rutherglen Muscat is typically tawny red in colour with aromas of rose petals, raisins and dried fruit. These characters carry through to the palate, balanced with fresh acidity. The wine is unctuous and rich yet zesty and balanced. 

102 | Lustau, San Emilio | Pedro Ximenez | Spain, Jerez | Bottle 75cl £69.95 | 125ml £12.85

Super-concentrated flavours of raisins and figs. Ebony coloured and lusciously sweet. Velvety and soft on the palate it retains a perfect balance and long finish.

104 | Sandeman Fine Ruby | Portugal | Bottle 75cl £45 | 50ml £4.50

Brilliant red ruby in colour, with clean aromas of red fruits, plums and strawberries. Full rich flavours and very well balanced.

105 | Sandeman, Tawny, 10 Year Old | Portugal | Bottle 75cl £68 | 50ml £6.50

Pale in colour and light in body, the nose opens with aromas of vanilla and raisins. On the palate, there is a great balance between fresh fruit flavours and more complex, spicy flavours from oak ageing. The finish is fresh and long lasting.

106 | Dalva Dry White, 10 Year Old | Portugal | Bottle 75cl £79 | 50ml £7.25

110 | Au Bon Climat 2021 | Chardonnay | USA, California | £90

The late Jim Clendenen made some of California's best chardonnay's and this is a great way into his style. Grapes from across Santa Barbara County are barrel fermented in French wood, although only a small percentage new, which has led to an intense apple and lemon-scented chardonnay with great mouthfeel and length.

111 | Vincent & Francis Jouard Chassagne-Montrachet 2021 | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £160

Based out of their ancestral estate at Chassagne Montrachet, brothers Vincent and Francois Jouard each take responsibility for one half of Domaine Vincent & Francois Jouard's winemaking process. Grown sustainably on old vines, the Chardonnay grapes that give the Chassagne-Montrachet Vieilles Vignes 2021 vintage its ripe citrus and orchard fruit aroma farmed with the utmost respect for the terroir. The resulting wine is full-bodied with brisk acids and a mouth-watering finish.

112 | Batar, Agricola Querciabella | Chardonnay & Pinot Blanc | Italy, Tuscany | £185

The Batàr is one of the most appreciated Italian wines. Laced with hints of tangerine oil, jasmine, spice and pear. Light tropical accents appear later adding gorgeous nuance throughout. Terrific freshness and plenty of style. Tasty, creamy and warm. Kissed with a final note of saffron.  

113 | Bouchard Meursault, Premier Cru 'Perrieres' 2011 | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £240

Aromas of fresh citrus and acacia flowers, subtly underlined by mineral notes and gentle wood. Full-bodied and rich, with a refreshing brightness. Crisp and fruity aftertaste.

114 | Bouchard Chevalier Montrachet Grand Cru 2015 | Chardonnay | France, Burgundy | £425

Distinguished bouquet, with floral and fruit aromas as well as a toasted note. Complex and rich, without the least heaviness, this wine is elegance itself

115 | Vina Arana Gran Reserva 2016 | Tempranillo | Spain, Rioja | £98

The nose show complex aromas of plums, red cherries and strawberries with nuances of vanilla, cinnamon and a delicate cigar box with tea leaf-like herbal notes. In the glass, the more savoury aromas of undergrowth, porcini mushroom, cured meat and a balsamic touch are simply beautiful. The palate feels fresh with well balanced, tannins are perfectly integrated spices all in wonderful harmony. Blackcurrants, wild strawberries and cherries intermingle with toasty notes of coffee bean and sweet spices, lingering on the palate that takes on to an earthy forest floor expression with a very long finish.

116 | Croix De Beaucaillou 2nd wine of Ch. Ducru-Beaucaillou 2017 | Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot & Petit Verdot | France, Bordeaux | £155

This exceptional Médoc cru is located between the river to the east and the centre and west of the Saint-Julien AOC area. Powerful, silky, very aromatic, La Croix Ducru-Beaucaillou seduces by its nose, its balance, it's remarkable finesse and its persistence.

117 | Chateau Pontet-Canet, Grand Cru Classé 2005 | Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot | France, Pauillac | £250

The 2005, Château Pontet-Canet has long been one of the stars of the vintage. It remains broody and introspective on the nose. Gorgeous scents of blackberry, briary and cassis fruit.

118 | Antinori Tignanello 2016 | Sangiovese & Cabernet Sauvignon | Italy, Tuscany | £285

A wine of extraordinary finesse. The 2016 Tignanello is a wine that opens, like a fully blossomed rose right in front of you. The fruit is beautifully ripe with fresh blackberry and cherry nuances, spice, leather, sweet tobacco and smoke.

119 | Yalumba, The Caley 2013 | Cabernet Sauvignon & Shiraz | Australia, Coonawarra | £320

Only the second release of Yalumba's flagship wine. Strikingly dynamic tannins are what distinguish it. Juicy plum and berry compote notes complemented by a lovely lick of smoky vanilla. Complex, seamless and quietly powerful.
